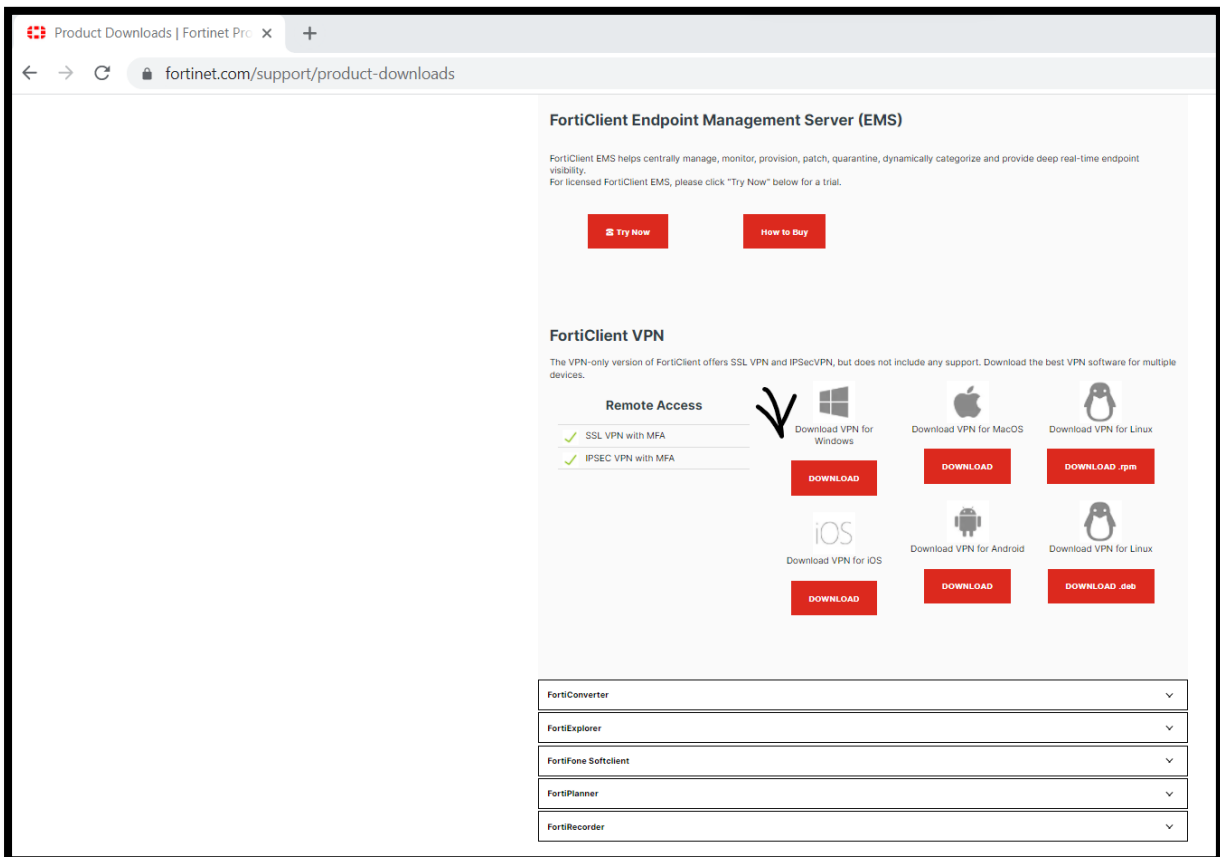




SOP SETUP VPN AKNS (FortiClient)

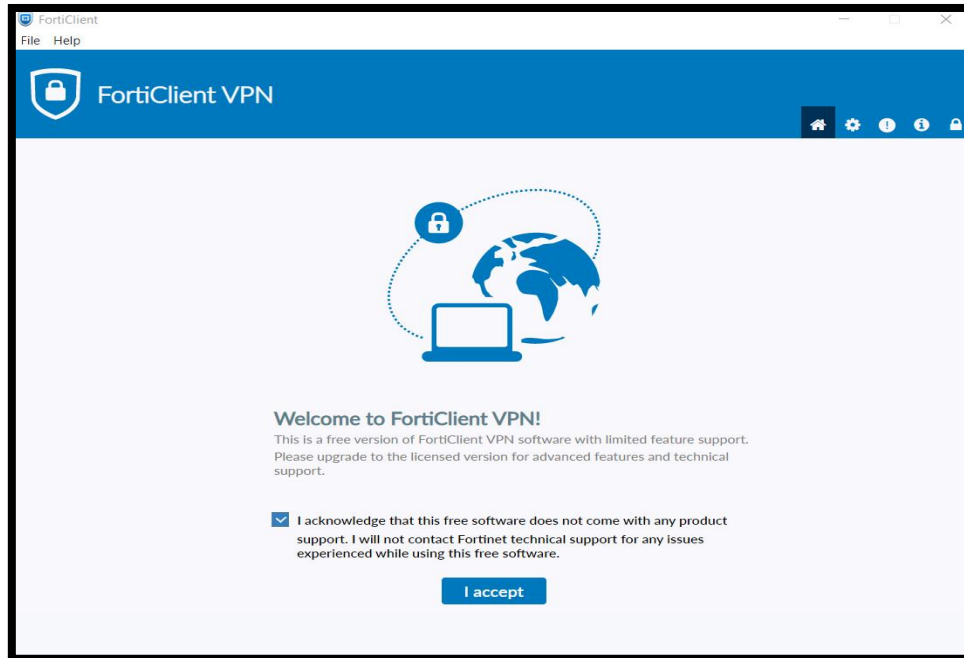
Installing and configuring FortiClient VPN

1. Follow the link below and download FortiClient VPN. Scroll down till you could see FortiClient.
 - To download the FortiClient 7.0.2, click this link [Click here](#)

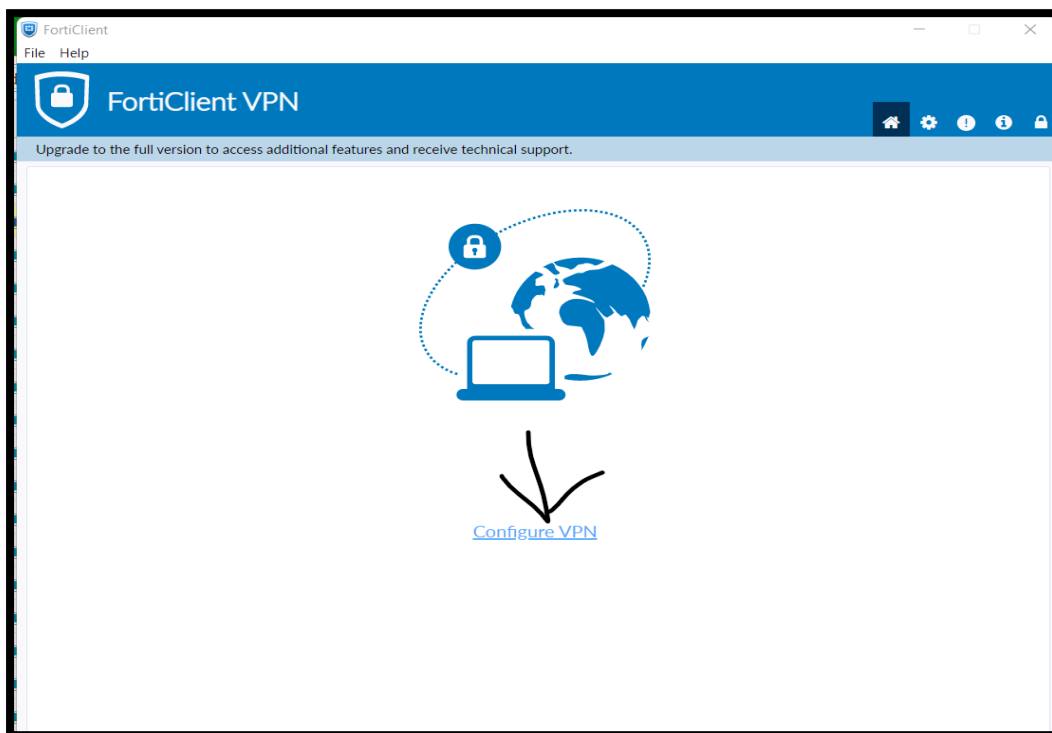


2. After completed the download, install the FortiClient by running the installation wizard.

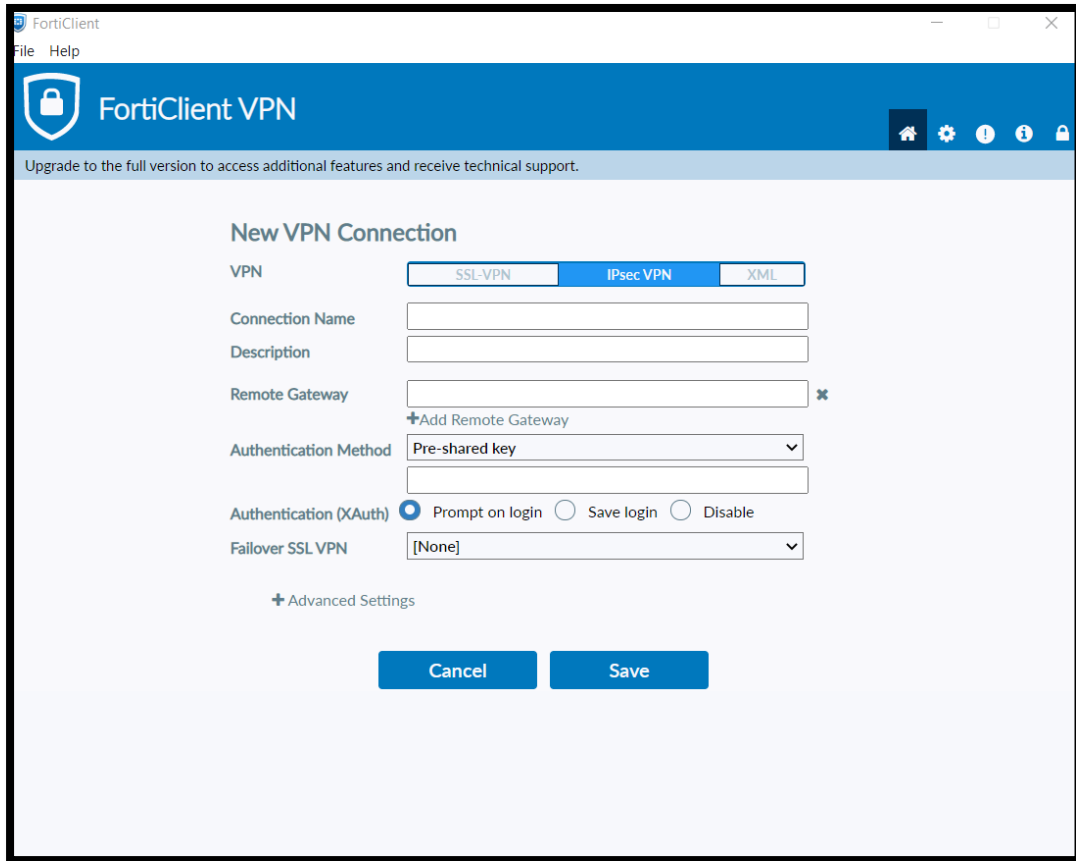
3. After installing, open FortiClient and you should be in this screen.

- After inputting, click save.

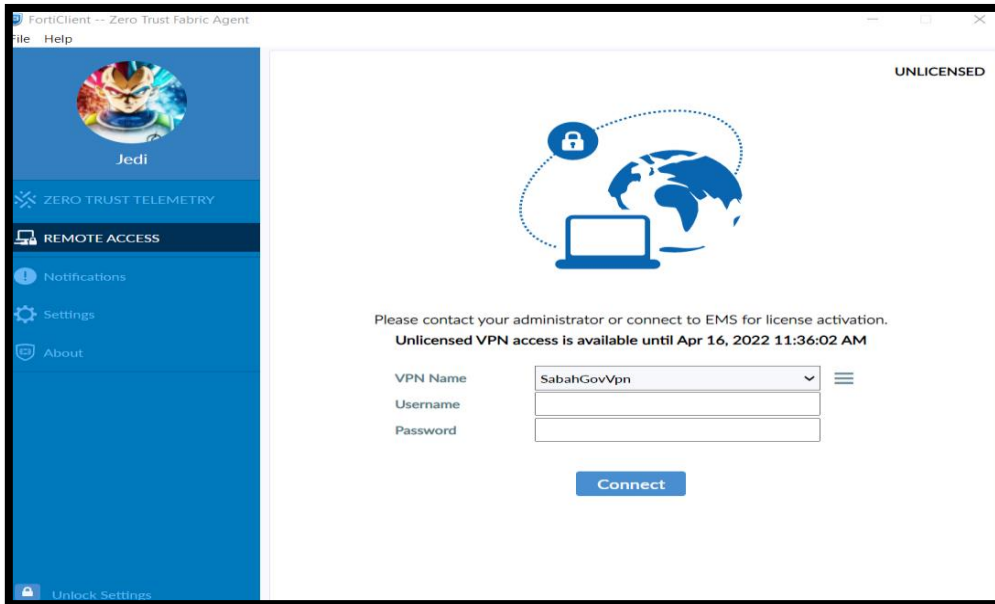

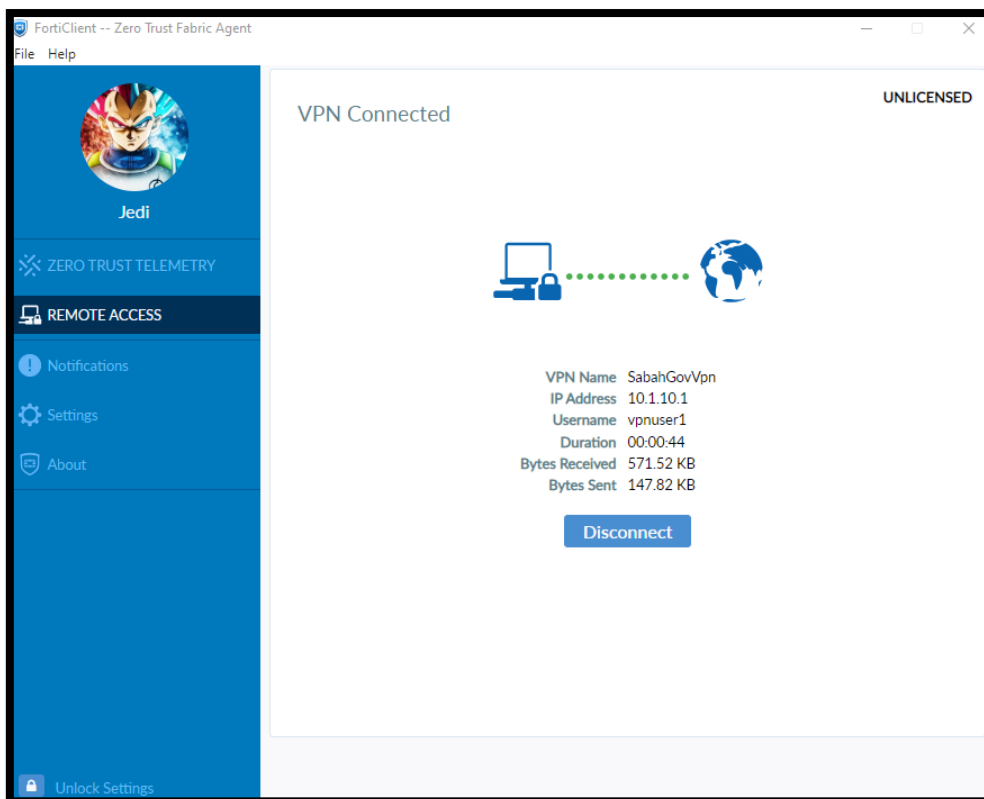
